What to Do During an Active Shooter Situation

Call 911 only when it's safe to do so



1. RUN

- \bigcirc Have an escape plan
- \bigcirc Evacuate
- Leave your belongings \bigcirc
- \bigcirc Help others if possible
- \otimes Don't move wounded people

2. HIDE

- \bigcirc Stay out of shooter's view
- \bigcirc Lock and block doors
- \bigcirc Keep options for escape
- Silence your cell phones \bigcirc
- \otimes Don't make noise





3. FIGHT

- \bigcirc Act aggresively
- \bigcirc Incapacitate the shooter
- \bigcirc Throw objects
- Yell and call for help \bigcirc
