# Background

As part of the Homeland Security Act of 2002, Congress passed the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Safety Act to save lives by aiding in the development of new technologies to detect, prevent, and mitigate the effects of terrorist attacks. Products are reviewed by an unbiased panel of five experts from federally funded research and design centers, non-profits, national labs, and academia.

### **Fighting Terrorism**

Mass shootings at the Pulse Nightclub in Orlando, Florida and the Inland Regional Center in San Bernardino, California were both found to be acts of terrorism.

During both incidents at venues with CCTV systems, shooters carried visible rifles from the parking lots into the buildings where the terrorist attacks happened.
