ABOUT IOWA HF2652

On May 17, 2024, Iowa Governor Kim Reynolds signed a bill, HF2652, to help improve Iowa safety measures—including the use of AI firearm detection.

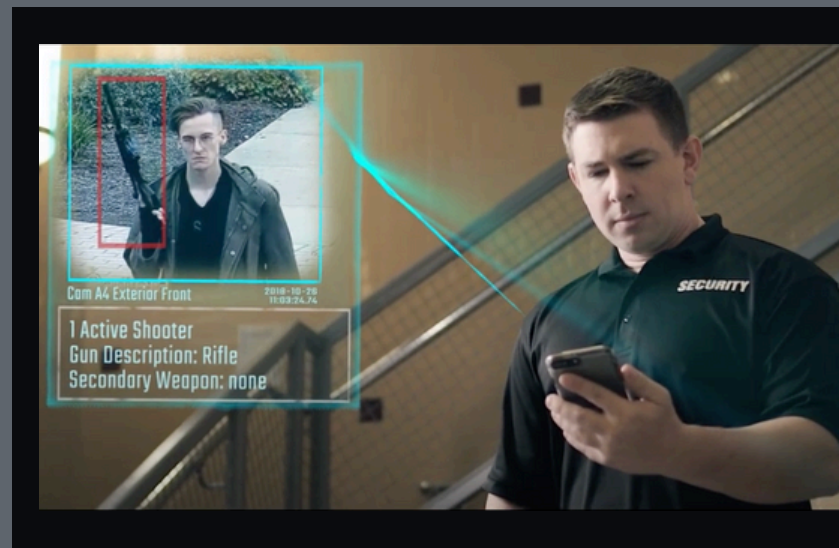
